

## **Fingerprint Clearance Cards**

Below is the link to the Arizona DPS website, where you can choose to apply for a "Level One, IVP" fingerprint clearance card. You will need to have a credit card ready for payment.

Follow these steps to apply for your Level One, IVP fingerprint clearance card:

- 1) Under Popular Public Service Links, select "Fingerprints";
- 2) Select "Fingerprint Card Public Services Portal;"
- 3) Select "Fingerprint Clearance Card"; then select "Apply for a Card / Request a Replacement";



4) You will be prompted to create a DPS account to apply & pay for a card;

5) If you will be a <u>classified/hourly paid</u> employee with CFSD, select <u>"Public and/or Charter</u> School" "Non-Certified Personnel" as the reason for your application; **OR** 

6) If you will be a **teacher** with CFSD, select the first option, <u>"State Board of Education (Teacher</u> <u>or Other Certification)</u>" as your reason for applying for a card;

7) Be sure you have selected a LEVEL ONE, IVP card.

8) If given an option for **digital rolling** choose this option. This is a faster process than paper card/ink rolling;

9) Continue to follow the prompts and enter a credit card number for payment;

10) After your payment is entered, you will receive an **Application Reference Number.** Check your DPS account **'message center'** for additional information about where to go to have your fingerprints rolled;

11) Please forward your **IVPP** Application Number to CFSD's HR Office (Elsa or Ann Marie), and we will monitor your card progress on-line. Most digital cards are processed and valid within a couple of business days.

## Cards are valid for six years and may be renewed online!

A wallet-sized plastic fingerprint clearance card will be mailed to you at the address in your application.

Please send us a copy of the front & back of your card for your CFSD file.
